AMENDATORY ENDORSEMENT HAWAII

 Under Definitions, the following additional phrase has special meaning when used in this policy:

Domestic abuse means:

- a. physical harm, bodily injury, assault or the infliction of fear of imminent physical harm, bodily injury or assault between family or household members;
- b. sexual assault of one family or household member by another;
- c. stalking of one family or household member by another family or household member; or
- d. intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing damage to property so as to intimidate or attempt to control the behavior of another household member.

2. Under Perils Excluded, Criminal, Fraudulent, Dishonest, Or Illegal Acts, if applicable, is amended to include the following:

However, if the loss is caused by an act of domestic abuse committed by or at the direction of an insured, this exclusion will not apply to an otherwise covered loss suffered by another insured who:

- a. did not cooperate with or contribute to the act that caused the loss; and
- b. files a police report and cooperates with any law enforcement investigation relating to the act of domestic abuse.

Subject to the "terms" under How Much We Pay and all other "terms" of this policy, "our" payment to an insured who did not cooperate in or contribute to the act that caused the loss may be limited to that person's insurable interest in the property, less any payment made to a mortgagee or other party with a legal secured interest in the property. "We" retain all rights set forth in the Subrogation condition of this policy with regard to action against the perpetrator of the act that caused the loss.
